Notice of Public Rights: AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS 2011/2012

Audit Commission Act 1998 (the Act),

Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011 (the Regulations).

The Authority's accounts are subject to external audit by Mr John Cornett (External Auditor) of the Audit Commission, Unit 10, Whitwick Business Centre, Whitwick Business Park, Stenson Rd, Coalville, LE67 4JP.

Local government electors for the area have certain rights in the audit process.

From **16 July 2012** to **10 August 2012** in office hours between 10.00 am to 4.30 pm any person may inspect the accounts of the Authority for the year ended 2011/12 and certain related documents (comprising books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts) at the address given below. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents.

From **13 August 2012** (between 10.00 am to 4.30 pm) until the conclusion of the audit process, a local government elector for the area of the Authority, or his/her representative, may ask the auditor questions about the accounts. Please contact the auditor at the address given above to make arrangements to ask any questions.

From **13 August 2012** (between 10.00 am to 4.30 pm) until the conclusion of the audit process, under S16 of the Act, a local government elector for the area of the Authority, or his/her representative, may object to the Authority's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest (under section 8 of the Act) and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 17 of the Act). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and copied to me at the address given below.
