To co-ordinate and develop the activities of the Authority in respect of its membership of crime and disorder and similar partnerships.</li> <li>b. To receive reports concerning strategic partnerships in the County and the City.</li> <li>c. To lead in the development and implementation of the Derbyshire Police Authority’s communication and consultation including ‘Have your Say’ and to make recommendations to inform future policy regarding local, divisional and strategic policing priorities.</li> <li>d. To oversee and receive reports on the development of neighbourhood policing and safer neighbourhood teams.</li> <li>e. To be the lead committee co-ordinating support and contact with our strategic partners.</li> <li>f. To monitor the work associated with the criminal justice system, including force performance taking note of the professional judgement scheme, the management of offenders and victim support.</li> <li>g. To liaise with other external organisations operating in Derbyshire, whether national, regional or local, and to ensure that the interests of local people are understood and noted including those of the young; the vulnerable, the elderly, and the voluntary and business communities.</li> <li>h.
