To promote, support, and monitor developments in regional collaboration working alongside the East Midlands Police Authorities Joint Committee (EMPAJC) and the Regional Collaboration Board.</p> <p>b. To receive regular reports from the Chief Constable and review progress and provide performance management on the Force’s response and preparedness to regional and national policing capabilities in the protective service areas including counter terrorism; domestic extremism; serious organised and cross border crime; civil contingencies and emergency planning; critical incident management; major crime; firearms; public protection; public order and strategic roads policing.</p> <p>c. To provide oversight and governance into the EMCTIU and act as the Authority’s focus on the EMSOU and any other specialist collaborative Units.</p> <p>d. Embed risk management, equality and diversity within its decision making process.</p> <p>e. To review and scrutinise the Constabulary’s performance against the corporate performance framework indicators within the committee scorecard.</p> <p>f. To oversee and co-ordinate the transition of the Derbyshire Police Authority to the Police and Crime Commissioner.</p> <p>g. To act as a ‘Special Committee’ and deal with all other issues requiring an urgent decision which cannot wait for the next Derbyshire Police Authority meeting, as required.</p> <p>h. To report to the Derbyshire Police Authority as required.</p>
